The Outreach Coordinator is largely responsible for:

- Facilitating awareness of JCF Missoula and motivate the participants into action
- Communicate initiatives that focus on grassroots solutions in support of Service Members, Veterans, and Families
- Expand on the Joining Community Forces campaign
- Demonstrate how JCF can be implemented at the community level
- Conduct monthly meetings
  - Organize other service providers involved
  - Confirm meeting times and locations
  - Obtain directions to the meeting
  - Provide a copy of the agenda to all meeting participants
  - Facilitate collaboration of government/non-government, non-profit, corporate partners, and local citizens
  - Identify examples of existing gaps in services and information development
  - Provide guidelines on developing sustainable networks of local support
  - Strengthen current collaborations
  - Provide participants solid examples of how they can develop community outreach action plans in their own organizations
- Explain to Service Area Leaders how they can assist in the identification of resources or resource providers
- Provide a real-life example of how a Veteran, Service member, or Family can benefit from community collaboration
